Staff Annual Pesticide Notification

Dear NSD staff member:

The Healthy Schools Act of 2000 was signed into law in September 2000 and requires that all schools provide parents or guardians of students and **all school staff members** with annual written notification of potential expected pesticide use at sites/schools. We, or our pest control vendors, may use the following pesticides at your site/school during the 2015-2016 school year:

Areas of Application: Interior and exterior areas and perimeters, as needed. Reason for application: To control pests from entering into classrooms and prevent herbicidal overgrowth. Weed abatement will normally be performed on weekends or when school is not in session.

Prior to the beginning of each school year, **ALL staff personnel** at National School District with a NSD assigned GroupWise e-mail will be sent this notification. This Staff Annual Pesticide Notification may be viewed at the National School District web site: (www.nsd.us) at NSD Home→For Staff→Annual Pesticide Notification. ALL staff personnel assigned to a site/school will be notified at least 72 hours before pesticides are scheduled to be applied at that site/school. Note: the 72 hours prior notification preceding an application requirement is not applicable during "Emergency" (time critical) applications.
