Lincoln Acres School is located in National City, California, a community south of San Diego. Lincoln Acres is a preschool to 6th grade elementary school. Sixty-two percent of our students are English Language Learners and eighty percent meet low-income criteria. The staff consists of 28 certificated teachers, 6 impact teachers, 20 classified employees and 5 support staff. We have 27 regular classrooms.
